Overview

The course provides a deep introduction to the regulatory, legal and practical issues that arise in the unitisation and joint development of petroleum resources. It is global in perspective. Unique features of this course are that it focuses on the development of resources that cross territory both on land and also at sea, and that cross distinct units within federal structures (whether on land or at sea). It provides the participants with an up to date overview of where the problems arise and how the stakeholders are making efforts to solve them. It provides a tool kit of practical methods of addressing the issues, whether for internationally operating petroleum companies or governments that are seeking to conclude agreements with neighbours. The orientation of this course will be to seek ways of ensuring that petroleum resources are developed most efficiently and speedily without being caught in a political quagmire. The course directors share their international experience of the issues in all the main petroleum bearing regions of the world. The practical orientation of the course is assisted by the use of class work and case study.
